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Woman Sues Blue Agave For Food Poisoning

CHICAGO (STNG) — A Chicago restaurant noted for fine Mexican food has been sued for food poisoning, according to the attorney for the plaintiff. The suit alleges Tamara Podjasek, 35, of Downers Grove, got sick after eating at the Blue Agave, 1 W. Maple St., on Aug. 14, 2005.

"She and her friends ordered ceviche and that evening they were sick," attorney G. Grant Dixon III of LaGrange said in a release. "Ms. Podjasek's injuries are very severe. She has been hospitalized since the food poisoning many times and endured several surgeries, incurring more than \$100,000 in medical expenses."

Ceviche is a popular Mexican appetizer made of uncooked fish, typically marinated in a citrus marinade, the release said.

The suit, filed Wednesday in Cook County Circuit Court, seeks unspecified damages.

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
